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Abstract

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This thesis is submitted to obtain a Master's degree in Arabic language majoring in language and syntax. It is an investigation of the book "*I'anat Al-Mubtadi' Al-Dha'if Ala Tafahom Ma'ani Muqaddemat Al-Tasreef*", (*Assisting the Weak Beginner to Understand the Meanings of the Introduction of Morphology*) by Ibrahim Bin Muhammad Bin Abdul Khaliq Al-Muzjaji (died in 1256 A.H), which is a valuable book in its field. The researcher aimed to extract and realize the efforts of the scholar Ibrahim Al-Muzjaji in explaining the introduction of morphology, for the benefit of students and researchers, and to give this great scholar his right to preserve his heritage from loss and neglect, and to enrich the linguistic library with the writings of distinguished scholars. The researcher also aimed to identify the personality of Al-Muzjaji and his status among the scholars of his time, as well as to explore various books of morphology explanations and delve deeper into this topic by examining the multiple efforts of distinguished scholars.

The study consists of two sections, preceded by an introduction in which the reason for choosing the topic and its importance is mentioned, as well as divisions. The study also includes a preface about the author's era (13th century - 19th century).

As for the first section, it was dedicated to the study, and included two chapters: The first chapter was dedicated to discussing the author of the book in terms of his name, birth, teachers, scientific position, the praise of scholars for him, his writings, and ended with mentioning his death. The second chapter was devoted for studying the book, discussing the title of the book, documenting its attribution to its author, explaining the author's methodology, how he dealt with his sources, his evidence, and his syntactic and morphological doctrine.

As for the second section, it included the authenticated text, in which the researcher diligently tried to present the book as closely as possible to the author's original. Then, a table of the book contents was provided to facilitate reference to its content, placed at the beginning of the study, followed by a conclusion, and then a list of sources and references used in the study.
